AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DUQUESNE, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2024-001 TO CLEARLY DEFINE BOATS AS A RECREATION VEHICLE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Duquesne desires to amend Ordinance 2024-001, to clearly define a boat as a recreation vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Duquesne hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

SECTION 1. Section V. D. (1) of Ordinance 2024-001, is deleted in whole and restated as follows:

D. It shall be unlawful for anyone to store trucks, trailers or commercial vehicles, recreational vehicles, motor homes, travel trailers, boats, or campers as defined in this ordinance, on properties in residential zoning districts unless they comply with the following rules:

- (1) Trucks, trailers or commercial vehicles, recreational vehicles, motor homes, travel trailers, boats, or campers shall not be parked or stored in any zoning district other than in rear yard or in a garage. Such storage shall not be located closer than three (3) feet to any side or rear lot line and ten (10) feet of any street line (not an alley).

SECTION 2. That this ordinance and the rules, regulations, provisions, requirements, orders and matters established and adopted hereby shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its final passage and adoption.
